ORDER

THIS CAUSE concerns Plaintiff Patrick William Oliver's appeal from a final decision of the Commissioner of the Social Security Administration (the "Commissioner") denying his applications for Disability Insurance Benefits ("DIB") and Supplemental Security Income ("SSI").
