ORDER

THIS CAUSE concerns Plaintiff Elizabeth M. Goldwire's appeal from a final decision of the Commissioner of the Social Security Administration (the "Commissioner") denying her application for Supplemental Security Income ("SSI") after proceedings before an Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ").¹ On January 9, 2018, the United States Magistrate Judge issued a Report and Recommendation (the "Report and Recommendation") recommending that the Commissioner's decision be affirmed (Doc. 20), to which Goldwire filed objections (Doc. 21) and the Commissioner filed a response (Doc. 22).

The ALJ's findings are supported by substantial evidence, and the ALJ applied the proper legal analysis to Goldwire's disability claims. After *de novo* review of the portions of the Report and Recommendation to which Goldwire objected, it is hereby **ORDERED** and **ADJUDGED** as follows:
