## **ORDER**

THIS CAUSE concerns Plaintiff Elizabeth M. Goldwire's appeal from a final decision of the Commissioner of the Social Security Administration (the "Commissioner") denying her application for Supplemental Security Income ("SSI") after proceedings before an Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ"). On January 9, 2018, the United States Magistrate Judge issued a Report and Recommendation (the "Report and Recommendation") recommending that the Commissioner's decision be affirmed (Doc. 20), to which Goldwire filed objections (Doc. 21) and the Commissioner filed a response (Doc. 22).

The ALJ's findings are supported by substantial evidence, and the ALJ applied the proper legal analysis to Goldwire's disability claims. After *de novo* review of the portions of the Report and Recommendation to which Goldwire objected, it is hereby **ORDERED** and **ADJUDGED** as follows:
