**ORDER**

This matter comes before the Court *sua sponte*. On November 27, 2017, this Court entered an Order (Doc. 19) denying Plaintiff's Motion for Default Judgment (Doc. 16) without prejudice, and granting Plaintiff leave to file an amended complaint within fourteen days<sup>1</sup> of the date of the Order or, alternatively, a second motion for entry of default judgment (Doc. 19).
