## **ORDER**

THIS CAUSE concerns Plaintiff Donna Y. Sweet's appeal from a final decision of the Commissioner of Social Security (the "Commissioner") denying her application for Supplemental Security Income ("SSI") after proceedings before an Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ").
