ORDER

This matter comes before the Court upon Plaintiff's Motion for Court's Entry of Default Judgment (Doc. 92). By the Motion, Plaintiff seeks entry of a default judgment pursuant to Rule 55(b)(2) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure against the Defendants (Doc. 92).
