## ORDER

This cause comes before the Court for consideration of Plaintiff's complaint seeking review of the decision of the Commissioner of the Social Security Administration (Doc. No. 1). This complaint was considered by the United States Magistrate Judge, pursuant to a specific order of referral. Magistrate Judge Wilson has filed his report recommending that the Commissioner's decision be reversed and remanded. (Doc. No. 18). - (3) The Clerk is directed to enter judgment in favor of Plaintiff, to terminate all pending motions, and to close the case.
