## **ORDER**


THIS CAUSE is before the Court on Plaintiff's Complaint (Doc. 1), which seeks judicial review of a final decision by the Commissioner of the Social Security Administration ("Commissioner") denying Plaintiff's claims for Disability Insurance Benefits and Supplemental Security Income benefits under 42 U.S.C. §§ 405(g) and 1383(c)(3).
