ORDER

THIS CAUSE is before the Court on Plaintiff's Complaint (Doc. 1). Plaintiff seeks review of the final decision of the Commissioner of Social Security ("the Commissioner") denying her Supplemental Security Income benefits. United States Magistrate Judge Gregory J. Kelly submitted a Report and Recommendation (Doc. 22), recommending that the Court reverse the Commissioner's decision pursuant to sentence four of § 405(g) and remand the case for further proceedings.

3. The Clerk is directed to enter judgment accordingly. Thereafter, the Clerk is directed to close this case.
