REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION

This cause comes before the undersigned upon periodic review of the case.

On June 4, 2018, Plaintiff, proceeding pro se, filed a complaint against Defendants. Doc.

1. Plaintiff, however, did not pay the filing fee or move to proceed *in forma pauperis*. Therefore, on June 6, 2018, the undersigned entered an order directing Plaintiff to pay the filing fee in full or file a motion to proceed *in forma pauperis* on or before June 20, 2018. Doc. 4 at 1. The undersigned warned Plaintiff that failure to timely comply with the Court's order would result in a recommendation that the case be dismissed without further warning. *Id.* at 2. As of the date of this recommendation, Plaintiff has not paid the filing fee or moved to proceed *in forma pauperis*.

Accordingly, it is **RECOMMENDED** that:

- 1. The case be **DISMISSED** without prejudice; and
- 2. The Clerk be directed to close the case.

NOTICE TO PARTIES

A party has fourteen days from this date to file written objections to the Report and Recommendation's factual findings and legal conclusions. A party's failure to file written objections waives that party's right to challenge on appeal any unobjected-to factual finding or legal conclusion the district judge adopts from the Report and Recommendation. *See* 11th Cir. R. 3-1.
