
ORDER

THIS CAUSE is before the Court on Plaintiffs' Motion to Remand ("Motion," Doc. 9) and Defendant's Response to Order to Show Cause (Doc. 11). United States Magistrate Judge Daniel C. Irick submitted a Report and Recommendation (Doc. 21) recommending that the Motion be denied as most and that the case be remanded to state court due to Defendant's failure to sufficiently establish that this Court has subject matter jurisdiction over the case.
