ORDER

This cause comes before the Court on Plaintiff's Application to Proceed *In Forma Pauperis* pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915, at docket 12, which was referred to the magistrate judge. The magistrate judge issued a report recommending the motion be denied and the complaint be dismissed. Dkt. 13. Plaintiff has not filed an objection.¹

The magistrate judge found that the allegations of the amended complaint (Dkt. 11) fail to establish a viable federal claim or to otherwise provide a basis for jurisdiction. For the reasons explained in the report and recommendation, the magistrate judge's recommendation (Dkt. 13) is **approved and affirmed** in all
