ORDER¹

Before the Court is Defendant Sylvanis Brice's Motion to Dismiss Indictment ([Doc. 65](#)), Uriah Waggeberby's Motion for Bill of Particulars ([Doc. 74](#)), and the Government's response to both motions ([Doc. 80](#)). After Defendants filed their motions, a federal grand jury issued a Superseding Indictment against them. ([Doc. 76](#)). Because Defendants' motions attack the original indictment that is no longer operative, the Court denies their motions as moot.

Accordingly, it is now

ORDERED:

(1) Defendant Sylvanis Brice's Motion to Dismiss Indictment ([Doc. 65](#)) is **DENIED as moot**.
