## PRELIMINARY ORDER OF FOREFEITURE<sup>1</sup>

Before the Court is the United States' Motion for Preliminary Order of Forfeiture. (Doc. 43). Now that Defendant has been adjudicated guilty, the Government seeks a preliminary order forfeiting his interest in an **iPhone XR**, **serial no. DX3YG2VHKXKN**, **seized on or about June 14**, **2023**. *See* 18 U.S.C. § 2253; Fed. R. Crim. P. 32.2(b)(2). In so moving, the Government has connected the iPhone XR, serial no. DX3YG2VHKXKN to the adjudicated offense. The Court thus finds the United States is entitled to possession of the iPhone XR, serial no. DX3YG2VHKXKN.
