ORDER

This cause is before the Court on Defendant’s Motion to Dismiss the Amended Complaint (Doc. 31 (the “**Motion**”)), filed February 4, 2024. Magistrate Judge Daniel C. Irick submitted a Report and Recommendation (Doc. 32 (the “**Report**”)) recommending that Defendant’s Motion be granted. No parties have filed an objection, and the time to do so has now passed.¹

After an independent *de novo* review of the record in this matter, and noting that no objections were timely filed, the Court agrees entirely with the findings of fact and conclusions of law in the Report.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** as follows:

1. The Report, filed March 13, 2024 (Doc. 32) is **ADOPTED** and **CONFIRMED** and made a part of this Order;
