ORDER


This matter is before this Court on pro se Plaintiff, Erick Alaniz's, Motion to Proceed In Forma Pauperis (Dkt. 2). On April 24, 2024, the assigned United States Magistrate Judge issued a Report and Recommendation (Dkt. 3) recommending this action be dismissed without prejudice because Plaintiff failed to provide a valid basis for this Court's jurisdiction. To date, no objections to the Report have been filed, and the time for doing so has passed.
