ORDER SETTING DEADLINES FOR CONSIDERATION OF MOTION FOR PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION

This cause comes before the Court upon Plaintiffs' request for a preliminary injunction (Doc. 8). Accordingly, the following is **ORDERED**:

- On or before February 14, 2024, Plaintiffs are directed to serve a copy of the Complaint, (Doc. 1), this Order, and the Motion for Preliminary Injunction, (Doc. 8), on Defendant. Plaintiffs must file a notice on or before February 15, 2023, confirming that they have complied with this instruction.
- 2. No later than **February 16, 2024**, the Parties must inform the Court whether

an evidentiary hearing will be required. If the Parties believe that a hearing will be required, they must inform the Court of its projected length.

- Defendant shall respond to the Motion for Preliminary Injunction (Doc. 8)
 within fourteen days of service of this Order and the motion.
- All parties are directed to strictly comply with the procedures set forth in Middle District of Florida Local Rule 6.02.
