ORDER

Before the Court is Defendants' Unopposed Motion for Entry of Stay Order. (Doc. 69.) The Private Securities Litigation Reform Act, which the parties agree applies here, provides an automatic stay of "all discovery and other proceedings" while a motion to dismiss is pending. 15 U.S.C. § 78u-4(b)(3)(B).
