**ORDER**

2. The Clerk of Court is directed to enter judgment **REVERSING AND REMANDING** this case pursuant to sentence four of 42 U.S.C. § 405(g) with the following instructions:

On remand, the Appeals Council will take any further action needed to complete the administrative record and issue a new decision. Plaintiff will be provided an opportunity for a hearing.

3. The Clerk is further directed to close the file.
